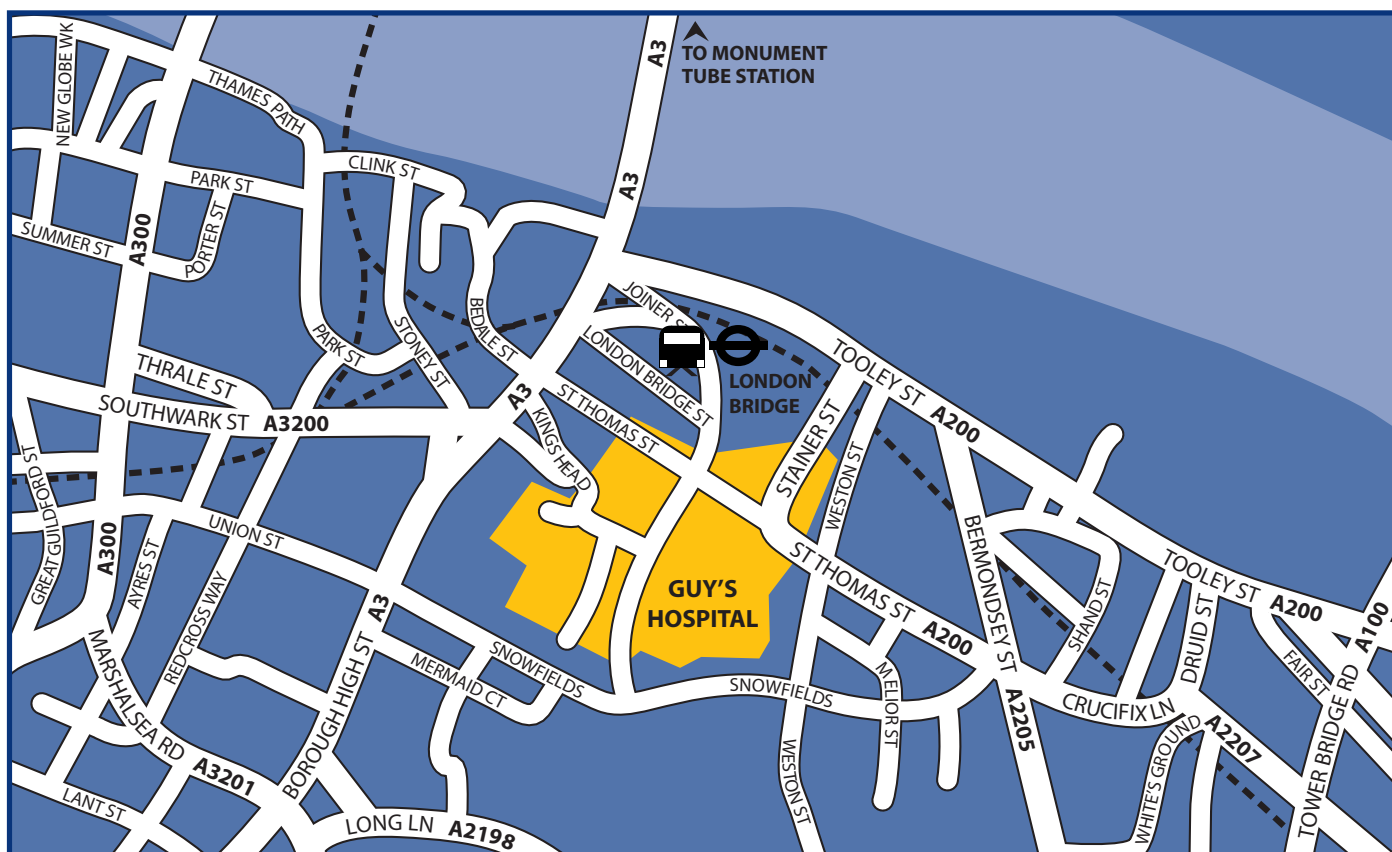


## How to find Guy's Hospital

### By road

Guy's Hospital is located on St Thomas Street which is just off the A3.



### Parking

There is no general parking, although there is limited disabled parking, and a drop off facility. There is a NCP car park at the junction of Snowsfield and Kipling Streets, about a two minute walk from the hospital. However, this car park is often full. Charges are displayed at the entrance. Please use public transport wherever possible.

### By bus

Bus route numbers which stop at London Bridge, London Bridge station or near Guy's hospital are as follows: 17, 21, 35, 40, 43, 47, 48, 133, 141, 149, 343, 381, 521, 701, RV1, C10, N21, N35, N47, N133, N343 and N381. Allow 15-20 minutes to get from the bus stop to where you need to be in the hospital.



### By rail

London Bridge is the nearest railway station. For further information, please call National Rail Enquiries on 08457 484950.



The nearest tube stations to Guy's hospital are London Bridge - Northern and Jubilee lines (five minute walk) and Monument - District and Circle lines (15 minute walk).

**Please report to the MRI unit, 2nd floor of the Tower wing. The entrance to the MRI unit at weekends is only via the main entrance of the Hospital.**
