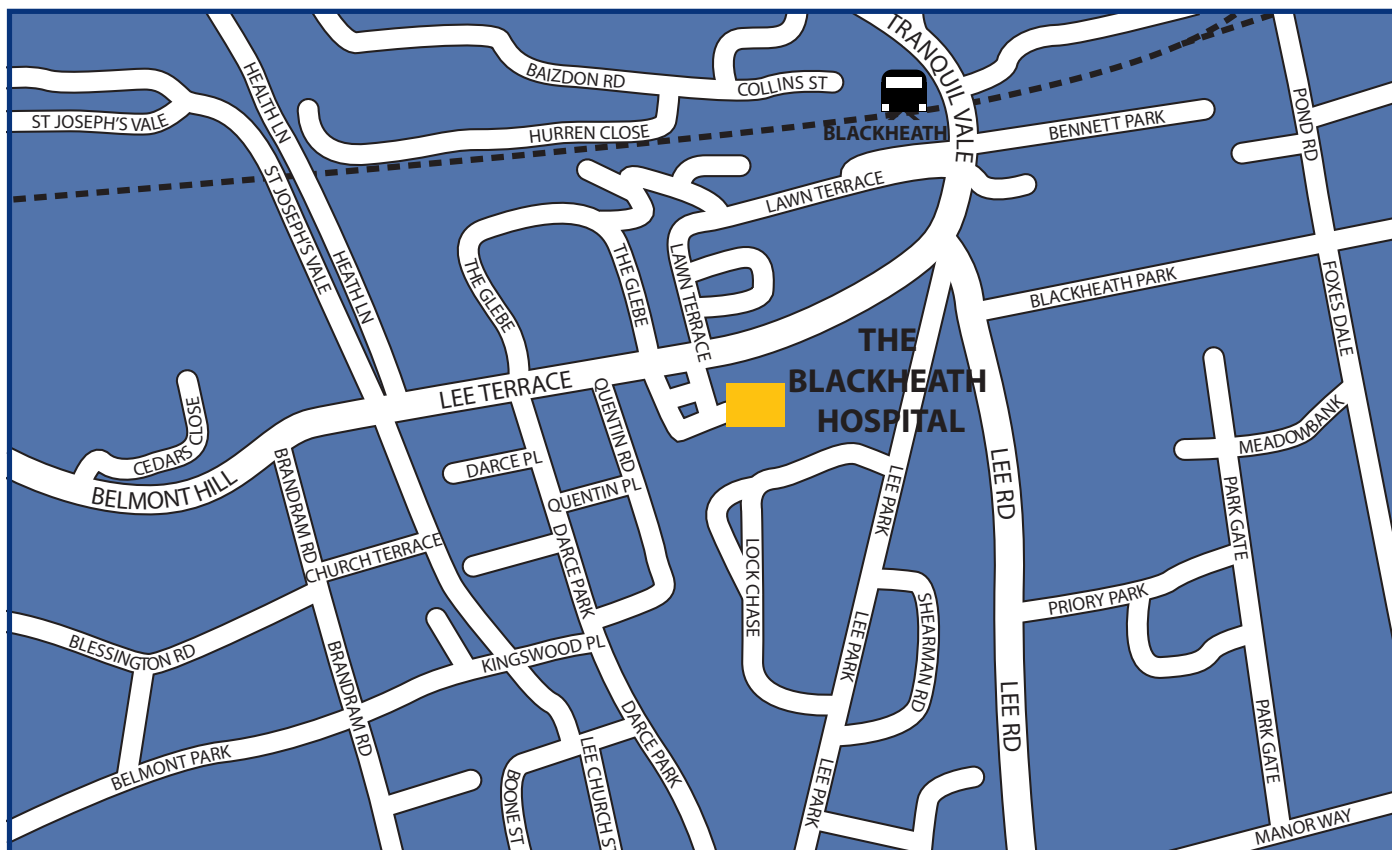


## How to find The Blackheath Hospital

### By road



The Blackheath Hospital is situated in Blackheath Village on the B220 and can be approached via the M25, A20 and A2.

### Parking

There is limited parking at the Hospital. There are public car parks at Blackheath station and behind Blackheath library.

### By bus



The following buses service the Hospital: 54, 89 & 108. All stop in front of the main Hospital on Lee Terrace.

### By rail



The nearest National Rail train station is Blackheath, which has connections to London Bridge, Charing Cross, Waterloo, Victoria and Kent. The station is about half a mile from the Hospital.
